Kathie is the Editor of four Association newsletters including the In-Home Aide Partners in Quality Care newsletter with a national readership. Kathie holds several certifications including Elder care and Work Balance; Integrated Chronic Disease Management Specialist Trainer; and, Coaching Supervision Master Trainer. Kathie has extensive experience as AHHC's liaison working with the NC Division of Health Service Regulations on Home Care licensing regulations and policies which impact NC patients, families and health care providers as well as the NC Division of Medical Assistance, the NC Department of Aging and the North Carolina Board of Nursing. She coordinates quarterly meetings between key Division staff within the NC Department of Health and Human Services and home care leaders to address quality and policy issues. Kathie recently was appointed to the Governor's Council on Aging for North Carolina.
